

Programme notes:

Written for the Orkest de Ereprijs 2015 Young Composers Meeting, this piece explores the kinds of echoes a bored soprano might find in a cave and her reactions to them, starting out by playfully exploring the echoes, getting scared when they overpower her own voice,

but then being too afraid of the silence to not at least attempt to win over the echoes.

Piano: the sustain pedal should be down throughout the piece.

Guitar and bass guitar: A slight delay and reverb pedal should be used throughout the piece.

Voices:

Sop I and M-S should always be echoing what Sop II is doing (including her expressions). When no pitch is given, Sop I is always higher than Sop II and M-S is always lower.

The piece should be acted out throughout.

te-ke-te-ke = should always be pronounced tə-kə-tə-kə

Any cresc./dim. not leading to a new dynamic is poco.



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repeat ad lib, gradually getting higher in pitch and more forced, accel. and cresc. from ff to ffff until end of bar feeling more and more helplessly out of control as the echo gets louder
